



3, 2, 1 BEST ON COURT FAIREST AND BEST POLICY

Purpose

The purpose of presenting a Fairest and Best award is to recognise the player within the each Division who performed the best, demonstrated good sportsmanship and who made the most impact during the season. The player who was deemed consistently best on court during the season.

Eligibility

All registered members are able to receive votes.

Process

The three best players overall from both teams are given the 3, 2, 1 votes.

The 3, 2, 1 votes are decided at the end of each match and written on the back of the score card. One representative from each team discusses and both agree who the three best players for the match are. The player's names and clubs are to be printed clearly on the back of the score card.

The winning team does not get 3 votes and 1 vote with the loser being allocated 2 votes. The votes are for the three best players on the court. That can mean that a player on the losing team can receive 3 points if it is deemed that they played a stand out game. It can also mean that all three votes can be given to three players from the same team or the winning team may have the top two best players overall so they receive the 3 and 2 votes.

The 3, 2, 1 votes is a decision between the two club's coaches or club representatives present at the match.

Allocation of the Award

The Fairest and Best Award is announced at the end of season senior Darwin Netball Association Presentation evening. The winner is announced and an appropriate token is presented to the successful recipient following the completion of the rounds where the votes are tallied.

The votes are tallied and the person who receives the most votes over the season is the winner.
