



GRAND FINAL BEST ON COURT POLICY

Purpose

The purpose of presenting a Best on Court award for the end of Season Grand Final is to recognise the player who performed the best, demonstrated good sportsmanship and who made the most impact during the Grand Final match. This player can be from either team.

Selection Panel Composition – A Grade Grand Final

For the A Grade Grand Final match a Best on Court Selection Panel will be made up of five people:

- Darwin Netball Association President or proxy
- Two appropriately selected people ie. Life Members, Patron
- Coaches from both competing teams

Selection Panel Composition – All Other Divisions

For the Division grand final matches a Best on Court Selection Panel will be made up of three people:

- Coaches from both competing teams
- One appropriately selected person who is not associated with either team or either club

Process

The Selection Panel democratically determines the most valuable player on the court. This is done by completing a voting slip in isolation to the other Selection Panel members.

The Darwin Netball Association will distribute voting slips before the commencement of the Grand Final match and the Darwin Netball Association's Administration Officer will collect and collate the voting slips after the game has concluded.

Allocation of the Award

The Best on Court award will be announced and an appropriate token will be presented to the successful recipient following the completion of the Grand Final.
