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## FUNDRAISING AT THE COURTS POLICY

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### Our commitment

The Darwin Netball Association (DNA) is supportive of those that wish to raise money for a good cause such as a charity, your club or because you have been selected to participate in a intrastate/interstate/international representative opportunity.

### Northern Territory Raffle Rules

Fundraising is the process of seeking and gathering voluntary financial contributions by engaging individuals, businesses, charitable foundations or government agencies, please refer to:

- You need to be an 'approved association' to run any kind of raffle for fundraising.
- In the NT you do not require a permit to run a raffle where the total value of ticket sales is \$5,000 or less.
- You need a minor lottery permit if the total value of ticket sales is between \$5,000 and \$20,000.
- You need a major lottery permit if the total value of ticket sales is above \$20,000.
- You can apply for a minor or major licence and you must submit your application at least 14 days before the commencement of the raffle.
- You cannot provide a prize for the seller of the most tickets, but you can provide a prize for the seller of the winning ticket.
- Liquor must not be a principal prize, this includes prizes consisting solely of money and liquor.
- All tickets included in the draw, and any unsold tickets, must be kept by the association for 12 months.
- The total value of the prizes must be at least one-third of the total value of the tickets or entry fees eg. a Raffle with gross receipts of \$5,000 must have prizes which value no less than \$1,667 in total.

### Process

If a club or individual would like to do any fundraising at the courts, requests must come through to the DNA in the first instance.

1. Request permission to raffle/fundraise must be emailed to DNA at [darwin.netball@gmail.com](mailto:darwin.netball@gmail.com)
2. Clubs/individuals are able to set up a fundraising table at the one of three of the following locations:
  - entrance of the stadium
  - under cover in front of the bar area
  - undercover area beside the canteen.
3. The fundraising table is not to block entry and egress points.
4. Fundraisers are not to walk the courts or the facility at any time while fundraising.
