Northern Territory Raffle Rules

Conditions on lotteries, raffles and games | NT.GOV.AU

- You need to be an 'approved association' to run any kind of raffle for fundraising.
- In the NT you do not require a permit to run a raffle where the total value of ticket sales is \$5,000 or less.
- You need a minor lottery permit if the total value of ticket sales is between \$5,000 and \$20,000.
- You need a major lottery permit if the total value of ticket sales is above \$20,000.
- You can apply for a minor or major licence and you must submit your application at least 14 days before the commencement of the raffle.
- You cannot provide a prize for the seller of the most tickets, but you can provide a prize for the seller of the winning ticket.
- Liquor must not be a principal prize, this includes prizes consisting solely of money and liquor.
- All tickets included in the draw, and any unsold tickets, must be kept by the association for 12 months.
- The total value of the prizes must be at least one-third of the total value of the tickets or entry fees eg. a Raffle with gross receipts of \$5,000 must have prizes which value no less than \$1.667 in total.

Process

If a club or individual would like to do any fundraising at the courts, requests must come through to the DNA in the first instance.

- 1. Request permission to raffle/fundraise must be emailed to DNA at darwin.netball@gmail.com
- 2. Clubs/individuals are able to set up a fundraising table at the one of three of the following locations:
 - entrance of the stadium
 - under cover in front of the bar area
 - undercover area beside the canteen.
- 3. The fundraising table is not to block entry and egress points.
- 4. Fundraisers are not to walk the courts or the facility at any time while fundraising.
